DIRECTIONS: Worcester Technical High School, 1 Skyline Drive, Worcester

FROM THE NORTH OR EAST: Take I-290 West to Exit 18. At the end of the ramp turn right onto Lincoln Street. Bear left at next traffic signal. Turn left onto Route 9 East/Belmont Street. At the top of the hill turn left onto Skyline Drive. Take a right onto the school grounds.

FROM THE SOUTH OR WEST: Take I-290 East to Exit 17. At the end of the ramp turn right onto Belmont Street. Proceed as in the directions from the North/East.
